Its programming is aimed at providing civic service through arts education while creating collaborations between Chicago area artists and youth. After three years of running, Co-op Image has become part of the neighborhood while it fills a key community need. Co-op Image provides innovative programs for area youth and artists. Since its launch in 2003, Co-op Image has:

- Provided safe environments and collaborated on innovative arts programming with over 1800 Chicago area youth.
- Obtained ownership of “Campbell Co-op Garden” from the city
- Helped Maintain “Our Block Community Farm”
- Opened a kitchen in Co-op’s “Corner Art Center” for a youth cooking show called “Chi-Town Chefs.”
- Created several youth-lead documentary program With CHA, CPS, ASM, and others.
- Produced dozens of murals throughout Chicago’s West and South sides
- Began the second year of “So Fresh Printing,” a youth-run screen printing business collaboration

Co-op Image Group is excited to announce the third annual **Fall into Art**, a benefit to support its after-school arts programs.
